At this meeting the following items will be considered and acted on:

1. Hear from the Public.
2. Consider approving minutes of the meetings held on August 20, 2026.
3. Conduct Public Hearing on 2026 Tax Rate.
4. Adopt Order Setting 2026 Tax Rate.
5. Amend Notice to Sellers and Purchasers.
6. Hear Auditor's Report and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. Approve Audit for fiscal year ended May 30, 2026 and authorize filing of same with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
7. Hear Financial Advisor's Report and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. Approve Order Adopting Official Notice of Sale and Preliminary Official Statement;
 - b. Authorize advertisement of bids for sale of the District's Series 2026 Unlimited Tax Bonds; and
 - c. Authorize consultants to proceed in preparing documents and to take any necessary actions related to the sale of the District's Series 2026 Unlimited Tax Bonds.
8. Hear Roman Forest Police Department Report and consider taking action thereon.
9. Hear a report from Waste Management and consider taking action thereon.
10. Hear Tax Assessor/Collector's Report and take any action requested, including:
 - a. Approve report and authorize payments from the tax account; and
 - b. Review delinquent tax accounts and consider termination of water service including authorizing door tags.
11. Hear Operator's Report and consider taking any action requested, including:
 - a. Review billing and collections;
 - b. Authorize termination of water and sewer service to delinquent accounts;
 - c. Authorize Operator to make necessary repairs to the regional and/or District water and sanitary system; and
 - d. Consider SJRA Global Amendment.
12. Hear Engineer's Report and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. Authorize the design of District and/or Master District facilities;
 - b. Approve plans and specifications for District and/or Master District facilities;
 - c. Authorize Engineer to advertise bids for District and/or Master District projects;
 - d. Approve report, pay estimates, and change orders for construction projects in progress in the District and/or Master District; and
 - e. Authorize and/or ratify construction contracts and related items.
13. Hear Regional Detention/Drainage Maintenance Reports and consider taking any action requested, including:
 - a. Authorize and/or approve proposals for maintenance of regional detention and drainage facilities.
14. Hear Bookkeeper's report and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. Approve report and payment of bills listed therein; and
 - b. Approve Master District true-up operating payments.
15. Hear report from Attorney and consider taking any action requested, including:
16. Such other matters as may come before the Board.
