 - b. Discuss tax levy for 2023;
 - c. Set public hearing and publish notice thereof;
 - d. Approve Order Adopting Official Notice of Sale and Preliminary Official Statement;
 - e. Authorize advertisement of bids for sale of the District's Series 2023 Unlimited Tax Contract Revenue Bonds; and

f. Authorize consultants to proceed in preparing documents and to take any necessary actions related to the sale of the District's Series 2023 Unlimited Tax Contract Revenue Bonds.

- Hear Bookkeeper's Report and take action thereon, including:
 - a. Approve Bookkeeper's Report and payment of bills relating to the Master District and District;
 - b. Adopt internal District budget for fiscal year end May 31, 2024;
 - c. Approve and authorize true-up report for Master District Operating Monthly Payments;
 - d. Consider approving Amended Bookkeeper Agreement; and
 - e. Approve Amended and Restated Investment Policy.
 - Hear Tax Assessor/Collector's Report and take any action requested.

 - e. Authorize and/or ratify construction contracts and related items.
